



We bring you the latest trends in the UK's housing market with a detailed focus on our local market.

House prices

In December the UK HPI (ONS) reported a 8.5% annual increase in house prices. The North West had the largest annual increase (11.2%) and London had the smallest (3.5%).

Economy

The UK economy shrank by 9.9% in 2020 as coronavirus restrictions reduced output. In December, the economy grew by 1.2% as some restrictions were eased, meaning the UK looks set to avoid its first double-dip recession since the 1970s.

Transactions

An estimated 121,640 transactions (seasonally adjusted) were recorded in January 2021, the highest January total since 2007 and 24.1% higher than January 2020 (HMRC). Transaction numbers remain high as many seek to complete purchases prior to the Stamp Duty Holiday deadline, currently the end of March.

Demand

103,381 mortgages were approved in December 2020, over 50% higher than in December 2019 and at £24.2 billion, gross lending was at its highest monthly figure since March 2016. Year-on-year mortgage approvals in 2020 were up 3.7% on 2019 (Bank of England), although the value of lending was 10% lower


Investment

According to ONS average rental values across the UK rose by 1.3% in the year to January 2021, the smallest annual increase since October 2019.
